## **Oakland Housing Authority's Appoints New Internal Auditor**

OAKLAND, Calif., Aug. 20, 2007 – The Oakland Housing Authority (OHA) announced today the appointment of Shelby Song to the position of internal auditor for the authority. Song began her new role on Aug. 13.

The internal auditor's office is part of the Office of Program Administration and will eventually be reporting to the now-vacant Deputy Executive Director of Program Administration.

Song received her Bachelor's Degree from Wellesley College, and attended such prestigious universities as Harvard and the University of Chicago. Song is a San Francisco resident and enjoys hiking, traveling, arts and the movies.
