

To Renew the Term of the Executive Director/Chief Executive Officer Employment Contract for an Additional Period from October 15, 2021 to October 15, 2022 with Automatic Annual Extensions Thereafter, approve an adjustment to the Executive Director's annual salary, and Approve the Notice of Renewal and First Amendment to Executive Director/Chief

Executive Officer Employment Contract

Funding:

This increase will be funded through salary savings from the Fiscal Year 2022 budget as approved by the Board of Commissioners on June 7, 2021. In budget line item: GL4110-00-000.

Background:

The Housing Authority of the City of Oakland ("Authority") and Patricia Wells ("Executive Director") entered into that certain Oakland Housing Authority Executive Director/Chief Executive Officer Employment Contract dated October 14, 2019 ("Agreement") to serve as the Authority's Executive Director/Secretary and Chief Executive Officer, as more specifically set forth therein. Th initial term of the Agreement commenced on October 14, 2019 with an end date of October 14, 2021, with the option to renew.

The Board of Commissioners has completed an annual review of the Executive Director and satisfied all requirements set forth in Section 5.C. of the Agreement. The Authority, based on the direction from the Transition Committee, recommends that the Board of Commissioners renew the term of the Agreement for an additional period from October 15, 2021 to October 15, 2022 with automatic annual extensions thereafter pursuant to the existing terms of the Agreement. In addition, the Authority, based on the direction from

the Transition Committee, recommends that the Board of Commissioners increase the Executive Director's base salary from Two Hundred and Sixty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$262,000) to Three Hundred and Ten Thousand Dollars (\$310,000), pursuant to Section 5.C. of the Agreement. The proposed salary increase was determined by utilizing the factors set forth in Section 5.C. of the Agreement, a component of which included the consideration of OHA's large scale residential property management operations, three non-profit affiliates OAHPI, CAHI and OHI/KHI, the operation of large PBV and PBRA portfolios, a full scale community services department and a PHA Police Department.

The Authority, based on the direction from the Transition Committee, also recommends that the Board of Commissioners, authorize and approve the form of Notice of Renewal and First Amendment to Executive Director/Chief Executive Officer Employment Contract attached to the Resolution as Exhibit A.

NOTICE OF RENEWAL AND FIRST AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR/CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT

THIS NOTICE OF RENEWAL AND FIRST AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR/CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT ("Amendment") is entered into as of September 13, 2021, ("Effective Date") by and between the HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, a public body corporate and politic ("Authority"), and PATRICIA WELLS, an individual ("Wells"). The Authority and Wells are individually referred to herein as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties."

RECITALS

- A. The Authority and Wells entered into that certain Oakland Housing Authority Executive Director/Chief Executive Officer Employment Contract dated October 14, 2019 ("Agreement") to serve as the Authority's Executive Director/Secretary and Chief Executive Officer, as more specifically set forth therein. All capitalized terms not defined in this Amendment will have the meaning ascribed to such terms in the Agreement.
- B. The initial term of the Agreement commenced on October 14, 2019 with an end date of October 14, 2021.
- C. The Authority desires to renew the term of the Agreement for an additional one year period pursuant to Sections 2.B., 2.C., and 5.C. of the Agreement, with automatic annual extensions thereafter pursuant to the existing terms of the Agreement.
- D. The Board of Commissioners have completed an annual review of Wells and satisfied all requirements set forth in Section 5.C. of the Agreement. As such, pursuant to the authority set forth in Board of Commissioners Resolution No._____the Authority desires to increase Wells' salary pursuant to Section 5.A. and 5.C. of the Agreement.
- E. The Parties desire to provide notice of renewal of the term of the Agreement pursuant to Section 5. B.ii. of the Agreement, to amend the Agreement to adjust Ms. Wells' salary and such other modifications as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is mutually acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. **Recitals**. The Recitals and attachments referenced above are incorporated in this Amendment by this reference and adopted by the Parties to be true and correct.
- 2. Notice to Renew Contract. Pursuant to Section 2.B. and 5.C. of the Agreement, the Board adopted Resolution No. _____ renewing Wells' contract for the additional period from October 15, 2021 to October 15, 2022, with automatic annual extensions thereafter. Both this Amendment

and Resolution No. _____ shall serve as the Board's notice of its intent to renew the Agreement prior to the expiration of the initial two-year term as required in Section 2.C. of the Agreement.

3. **Renewal Terms.** Section 2.B. of the Agreement titled, "Renewal Terms" is hereby amended in its entirety to add the following clarification language after the first sentence:

"It is the intention of the parties that this provision shall operate as an "automatic extension clause" so that the Contract will automatically be extended for one additional year as of each anniversary of the Effective Date and so that the Agreement (if not earlier terminated by notice of either party as described herein) shall always have a remaining one year term."

4. <u>Salary.</u> Pursuant to Section 5.C. of the Agreement, as of the Effective Date of this Amendment Wells' salary shall be Three Hundred and Ten Thousand Dollars (\$310,000) annually for the period through October 14,2022, adjusted annually by a Cost of Living percentage equal to the amount provided other unrepresented OHA staff on July 1 of each year. Payment of the salary will be made in bi-monthly installments, with payroll deductions for taxes and other items deducted as if Wells were an employee not subject to a contract. Pursuant to Section 5.C. of the Agreement, the effective date of the salary so determined in this Paragraph 4. shall be retroactive to July 1, 2021.

5. Miscellaneous.

- a. <u>Further Cooperation</u>. The Parties agree to execute such other instruments, agreements, and amendments to documents as may be necessary or appropriate to effectuate the Agreement as amended by this Amendment.
- b. <u>Interpretation</u>. This Amendment, when combined with the Agreement, sets forth and contains the entire understanding and agreement of the Parties. There are no oral or written representations, understandings, or ancillary covenants, undertakings, or agreements, which are not contained or expressly referred to within this Amendment or the Agreement.
- c. <u>Attachments</u>. Each of the attachments and exhibits attached or to be attached to this Amendment are incorporated in this Amendment by this reference.
- d. <u>Effectiveness of Agreement</u>. Except as modified and amended by this Amendment, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unmodified and in full force and effect.
- e. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Amendment may be signed by the Parties in counterparts, each of which will be an original but all of which together will constitute one and the same Agreement.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners have completed an annual review of the Executive Director and satisfied all requirements set forth in Section 5.C. of the Agreement;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 2.B., 2.C., and 5.C. of the Agreement the Board of Commissioners desire to renew the term of the Agreement for an additional period from

October 15, 2021 to October 15, 2022 with automatic annual extensions thereafter pursuant to the existing terms of the Agreement;

WHEREAS, effective as of the date of this resolution, the Board of Commissioners desire to increase the Executive Director's base salary from Two Hundred and Sixty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$262,000) to Three Hundred and Ten Thousand Dollars (\$310,000), pursuant to Section 5.C. of the Agreement. THAT, the Board of Commissioners hereby extends the term of that certain Oakland Housing Authority Executive Director/Chief Executive Officer Employment Contract dated October 14, 2019 and executed by the Housing Authority of the City of Oakland ("Authority") and Patricia Wells ("Executive Director") ("Agreement") for an additional period from October 15, 2021 to October 15, 2022, with automatic annual extensions thereafter pursuant to the existing terms of the Agreement; and
